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Dr. Laurence de Leval is Director of the Institute of Pathology at the University Hospital of Lausanne, and full Professor of Pathology at the University of Lausanne, Switzerland. She received her medical degree from the University of Liège (Belgium) where she performed a PhD in experimental pathology, and completed a two-year postdoctoral fellowship in hematopathology at Harvard Medical School. Her research on non-Hodgkin's lymphoma was awarded the InBev-Baillet Latour Prize for Clinical Research in 2009 and she received the Benjamin Castleman Award from the United States and Canadian Academy of Pathology (USCAP) in 2008 for her discovery of the follicular helper T-cell derivation of angioimmunoblastic T-cell lymphoma. Dr. de Leval is an internationally recognized expert in hematopathology and the author of more than 300 scientific publications, as well as several chapters in reference textbooks. Dr. de Leval is the Pathology Chair of the LYSA (LYmphoma Study Association) T-cell lymphoma Working Group and a reference pathologist for clinical trials. She is a member of several national and international scientific societies, an elected member of the International Lymphoma Study Group and a corresponding member of the Belgian Royal Academy of Medicine.



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
