Course Overview:

Menopause affects over 50 million women in the U.S., often leading to symptoms that can reduce quality of life, productivity, and long-term health. Despite its prevalence, menopause care is often fragmented and inconsistently delivered. As women approach menopause, they may experience symptoms and body system changes that impact both daily life and future health. This inaugural CME conference will prepare providers to educate patients about the menopause transition and beyond. Experts in women's menopausal health and aging will address topics such as hot flashes, sleep and mood changes, brain fog, sexual dysfunction, weight management, exercise, and long-term risks including osteoporosis, heart disease, and cancer. The conference will also promote collaboration among women's health providers at UVA to advance conversation, knowledge, research, and education about menopause, ultimately improving care for women in Virginia and at UVA.
