Course Overview:

This conference will represent a forum to discuss unusual cases, new technologies particularly around complex coronary artery disease and structural heart interventions, and presentation of clinical problems where there is not consensus on management or diagnosis. The conference is enhanced by allowing robust input from numerous and diverse practitioners. This forum brings together practitioners from Charlottesville, such as UVA and Martha Jefferson, and the surrounding communities, to include Augusta, Lynchburg, Northern Virginia, Culpeper and Rockingham. The forum will also promote interprofessional learning by including technologists and nurses from the various laboratories on a rotating basis.

Spring topics:

- Structural Interventions for Tricuspid Regurgitation
- HCM: alcohol septal ablation vs surgery vs medical therapy
- Peripheral vascular interventions: CLI
- Peripheral vascular interventions: complex PAD
- Unusual coronary case

Desired Outcomes:

After participating in this activity, participants will be able to:

- Discuss the rapidly changing advances in surgical and catheter-based techniques for management of coronary, valvular and structural heart disease.
- Describe best practices for accurate diagnosis and timely management of cardiovascular disease and the implementation of current standards of care for diagnosing and treatment acute and chronic cardiovascular disease including acute coronary syndromes, STEMI, chronic stable angina, heart failure and valvular disorders.
- Identify the value of establishing protocols and implementing standardized methods of care for cardiovascular procedure-based medicine across institutions. Learn the value of effective collaboration of healthcare teams and institutions to optimize patient outcomes.
- Facilitate effective communication between healthcare teams and institutions that maximize patient-centric care and promote quality patient care.
- Compare and contrast clinical scenarios and outcomes to improve protocols and standards of care.
- Discuss unusual cases, presentations or clinical problems that do not have general consensus on management or diagnosis and allow input from numerous practitioners.

Total Number of Expected Audience: about 12 physicians and APPs from all subspecialties in Cardiology as well as from Cardiothoracic Surgery.
